On September 29, 1929 young women interested in literary study organized the "Read More Club". The club was later renamed the "Junior League Club". In 2004, the Junior League Club developed a campaign entitled "Women Helping Women Legacy Fund" to improve the health and wellbeing of women in Dickinson County. Although the main mission of Junior League is to provide a service to the community, the club also values the social aspects of women working together for a common goal.

Scholarship Deadline: April 19th, 2024

Scholarship Requirements:

- Applicant must be a female graduating senior or alumni of a Dickinson County high school
- Applicant must plan to attend or currently attend a postsecondary institute or vocational program in Kansas
- Applicant must have earned a minimum of a 2.0 accumulated GPA
- The following information shall be included in the application:
  - The completed application cover sheet
  - Resume school and community
  - An essay (250-500 words) detailing what you have done through volunteer work to give back to your community during your high school/college years.
  - A copy of a high school/college transcript
  - A recommendation letter from someone who can verify your community involvement.

Scholarship winner will receive two payments, one prior to the fall semester and one prior to the spring semester. Checks will be made out to the school you will be attending. A transcript will be required before receiving the second semester payment.
